**AN OPEN LETTER TO ALL PARTIES INTERESTED IN BESTNET EUROPE
LIMITED AND ITS PRODUCT "NETPROTECT"**

Dear Sirs

Bestnet Europe Limited and its product "Netprotect"

We continue to act for Bestnet Europe Limited ("Bestnet") in connection with proceedings which were commenced in the High Court in London in January 2007 by Vestergaard Frandsen ("VF"). We have been asked to provide you with an update on the situation following the further hearing which took place on 21 May 2009 which was mentioned in our previous open letter dated 14 May 2009.

Once again, we understand that you may have been told that the sale of Netprotect has been forbidden. This is completely untrue.


The hearing on 21 May 2009 did take place and the Judge heard further argument in relation to remedies and various other issues but at the end of the hearing he announced that he would be taking time to consider his decision and gave no indication as to when this would become available.

In short, the position remains exactly the same as it was when we wrote our letter of 14 May (save that the Judge has now heard further argument). In particular, VF have not obtained an injunction in the UK and if the Judge confirms the remarks made in his original judgment, there is, and will be nothing to prevent future manufacture or sale of Netprotect.

It is therefore still the case that there are no Court orders of which we are aware in any jurisdiction which prevent the manufacture and sale of Netprotect.

We will provide you with a further update when the decision of the Judge is known.
